



Common Abbreviations

For author abbreviations use *Authors of Plant Names* (1992, by R. K. Brummitt and C. E. Powell, Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew).

Herbarium abbreviation can be found in Index Herbariorum (<http://sciweb.nybg.org/science2/IndexHerbariorum.asp>).

Journals cited in nomenclatural text should be abbreviated following BPH-2 (*Botanico-Periodicum-Huntianum*, second addition. 2004. Hunt Institute for Botanical Documentation.) or an earlier version (1968 and 1991). (<http://huntbot.andrew.cmu.edu/HIBD/Publications/HI-Pubs/Pub-BPH-2.shtml>)

Books cited in nomenclatural text should be abbreviated following Taxonomic Literature, second edition.

In general, only author names should be abbreviated in the general text.

The following abbreviations are generally used in taxonomic treatments (e.g., specimen citations and descriptions).
