Warm up around the handcrafted **fire pits** in the Leon Levy Visitor Center, feel the excitement of the season with **artistic ice carving** by Okamoto Studio NYC and **festive performers** such as contortionists and acrobats from American Circus Theatre, sing along with **dueling pianos** in the Pine Tree Café, and enjoy **DJ sets curated by Uptown Vinyl Supreme**. The New York Botanical Garden's *Holiday Train Show* showcases Central Park and its iconic architectural treasures in the 28th year of this beloved tradition. Enchanting model trains zip through a display of more than 175 New York landmarks, each re-created with bark, leaves, and other natural materials. This year, the *Holiday Train Show* is presented in an immersive indoor winter wonderland adjacent to the Enid A. Haupt Conservatory as the Conservatory's palm dome undergoes restoration. Replicas debuting this year include the Belvedere Castle, the Dairy, the Naumburg Bandshell, Bethesda Terrace, and two graceful pedestrian bridges. The *Holiday Train Show* runs through Sunday, January 26, 2020.
